Dr. Kleissner co-founded the <u>Impact Hub Tirol</u>, <u>Toniic</u>, a global network for impact investors and Toniic's <u>100% Network</u>, a global group of asset owners dedicated to 100% impact, currently representing over \$10 billion in assets that are actively moving into impact.

Dr. Kleissner serves as a full member of <u>The Club of Rome</u>, as the chair of the supervisory board of <u>Alia</u>, on the Board of the <u>Schwab Foundation for Social Entrepreneurship</u> and <u>Proof</u>, on the Advisory Board of <u>Chi Impact Capital</u>, <u>Industree Foundation</u>, <u>MCI Business School</u>, <u>Commonland</u>, and <u>Rainfall</u>, and as the chair of the ethical committee of <u>tree.ly</u>.
